MESSAGE FROM MAYOR PATRICK JACOB

By the time you get this, the Holiday Season will be well underway. I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving.

Last Month Your Town Administrator, Dianna Buchanan, attended the North Texas Commission Regional Water Resources Summit. The topics were long-term planning for our water supply in North Texas, conservation and best management practices. These are all important issues the Town needs to maintain awareness of and keep you informed about. Future population growth and drought conditions will require much more serious conservation efforts and long term planning to assure water will continue to be readily available for all Texans.

Back in June, the newsletter let everyone know that the town council had voted to rejoin the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Each year, the Cities of Tarrant County leverage thousands of local dollars for investment into our communities' aging infrastructure. As would be expected, federal funding has been reduced again for FY 2012. We will still make applications for funding to benefit Lakeside.
