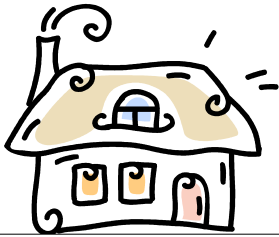

On Saturday, February 20th, the Shredinator will be coming to the Town Hall parking lot to shred documents. The shredder will be here from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. This service is available to anyone from Lakeside and surrounding areas. Any papers can be shredded whether they are personal or business. You will receive a certificate of destruction for the items that are shredded. The cost is \$0.18 cents per pound. Forms of payment are cash or credit card. Shredding is environmentally friendly and a great device for identity theft protection.

## LAKESSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT AWARDED FY 2010 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

The Town of Lakeside Police Department received a FY 2010 Justice Assistance in the amount of \$57,759. This grant is funded by federal monies from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and are part of the stimulus funds that are trickling down to communities across the country. These funds will be used to provide additional hours of patrol in Lakeside neighborhoods and funding of training for officers. Funds do not have to be matched or paid back. Staff is required to file reports with the State on the expenditure of the grant funds. Congratulations to Chief Pitts and his staff for acquiring these funds to supplement the Police Department's budget.

## ELECTION FOR CITY COUNCIL

The first day to file to run as a candidate for City Council is February 5th. The last day to file is March 8th. ## MESSAGE FROM MAYOR PATRICK JACOB

At the next Council meeting, February 11th, there will be a presentation by Staff covering the work that is progressing on the water system improvements and the waste water system (sewer) improvements. There has been significant change to both systems which will result in compliance with State regulations. The Planning and Zoning Commission has been working with the town's consultant on updating the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map. The fruit of their efforts will be brought to City Council for consideration of approval this Spring. The potential cabaret that was advertised along Jacksboro Highway just outside of the Lakeside city limit will not be opening. There may be a pool hall or some other similar business, but no cabaret.

## Residential Garbage Collection

Residents are offered twice weekly pickup of garbage by IESI. It is collected on **Tuesday and Friday**. Trash will not be picked up on July 4th, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. The service includes pickup of normal household waste and on-going bulk pickup of some items. There are some restrictions and some alternative options. Contact IESI at 817-222-2221. Garbage & Recycling must be at the curb no later than 7:00 A.M. IESI begins servicing routes at 7AM and typically finishes by 7PM. All household **waste must be bagged and tied**. Each resident will provide and use containers for trash that securely close to prevent trash from spilling or blowing into neighboring yards or streets and to render said containers inaccessible to insects, rodents and other animals. Containers may be **placed at the curb the evening before pick-up day** and must be removed from the curb when emptied. Items must be placed within six feet of the curb. **DO NOT PLACE HOT ASHES, LIQUIDS SUCH AS MOTOR OILS OR GREASE, OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SUCH AS CAR BATTERIES OR LEAD BASED PAINTS INSIDE GARBAGE BAGS TO BE PICKED UP.**

## Recycling

Recycling is picked up on **Friday** by a separate truck. Recycling Containers are available at Town Hall. Items accepted include paper, cardboard, #1-5 & #7 plastics, glass, aluminum and tin. Steel products are not accepted for recycling. Christmas tree recycling is provided each year on your regular trash days.

### Acceptable Recycle Items are:

- Metal cans
- Chipboard (cereal boxes, soda boxes, etc.)
- Glass bottles or jars
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Phone books
- Plastics # 1 - #7 (milk jugs, juice jugs, laundry detergent jugs etc.)
- Junk mail advertisements

### Unacceptable Recycle Items are:

- \*No mirrors, window glass, plate glass
- \*No plastic bottle tops for plastic bottles
- \*No light bulbs, ceramics, aluminum foil, pizza boxes
- \*No packing peanuts or Styrofoam
- \*No aerosol cans, paints, solvents or thinners
- \*No pool chemicals, plastic toys, furniture, rubber hoses
- \*No household items, garden fertilizers, pesticides
- \*No hardback books, propane/helium tanks
- \*No waxed juice or milk cartons, tissues
- \*No wet paper or paper contaminated with food products
