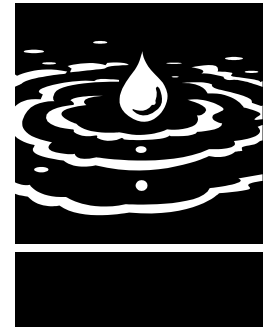

WATER CONSERVATION PLAN

MAY 1ST THRU SEPTEMBER 1ST

The Water Conservation Plan is effective beginning May 1st and will end September 1st of each year. The plan requires residents to only water every other day.



No property may use water for watering and landscaping purposes at any time on Mondays.

No watering is allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day.

Even postal addresses can water within the allowed time on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Odd postal addresses can water within the allowed time on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.

Hand Water of plants & flowers, not to include grass, is allowed any day during the permitted hours.

MESSAGE FROM MAYOR PATRICK JACOB

The Lakeside water supply is entering Summer 2010 in the best shape ever. The water plant improvements are done. All the problems from the 2005 rationing are corrected. Water conservation is still the key to our Town's continued success and May begins our Town's annual water conservation program. The improvements to the sewer plant are progressing on schedule. Construction is ongoing at the site and commissioning of the new system is expected in July. The difference between the prior sewer system and the improved system is very extreme, like scrapping a junk car you wouldn't let your children sit in or much less drive. On another note, I recently have received a rash of e-mails regarding the Cap and Trade Act and how it will affect our lives. This Act would require each homeowner to have a required federal home energy inspection similar to the annual car inspection that is required by the State. There would also be federally mandated levels required for a home to qualify for sale. I have contacted our congressional representative to get more information on this and requested to be kept updated on this proposed legislation.

I will keep you posted.

In the event that you become incapacitated or unconscious, first responders such as Paramedics or Emergency Medical Technicians can have quick knowledge of your medications and allergies by keeping this Vial of Life in the side door of your refrigerator. The vial contains an information sheet where you list all of your prescriptions and other pertinent medical information. It also contains a label that you post on your front door that alerts first responders that you have the Vial of Life. 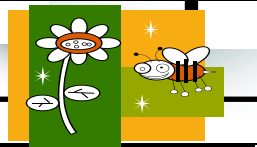


CITY COUNCIL ELECTION CANCELED AS ALL CANDIDATES UNOPPOSED
